**Resolution in Appreciation for and Support of the Role of
The Center for Domestic Peace in Jackson County**

WHEREAS, the Center for Domestic Peace (CDP) was established in 2013 to provide timely, compassionate support for Jackson County residents who are victims of interpersonal violence; and

WHEREAS, interpersonal violence is described as violence against an intimate partner, sexual assault, or stalking which can take many forms such as physical, emotional, psychological, sexual, or economic; and

WHEREAS, in 2018, 228 people from Jackson County sought help and services for domestic violence through REACH of Macon County, in partnership with the CDP; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Sylva Board of Commissioners support the efforts of the CDP in becoming a standalone agency focused exclusively on the needs of the people of Jackson County; and

WHEREAS, grant funding and community support are crucial to obtain in order for the CDP to take over domestic violence services in Jackson County by mid-2020; and

WHEREAS, the CDP office on 26 Ridgeway Street in Sylva is open daily to offer public support, arrange housing in hotel rooms, provide gas vouchers to help with transportation, and connect victims to other services such as therapy, or social services for both adults and children victims; and

WHEREAS, the Center for Domestic Peace also operates a hotline for emergencies (828-586-8969) in both English and Spanish; and

WHEREAS, the CDP works as a victim's advocate to find resources in law enforcement legal aid, how to seek protective orders, and bring criminal charges against their abusers; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Sylva Board of Commissioners adopt this resolution in appreciation of the Center for Domestic Peace's role of victim advocacy, and support their mission to end all forms of interpersonal violence in Jackson County; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town of Sylva Board of Commissioners, that the Town recognizes and supports the important role of the Center for Domestic Peace in providing invaluable public services for Jackson County.
